
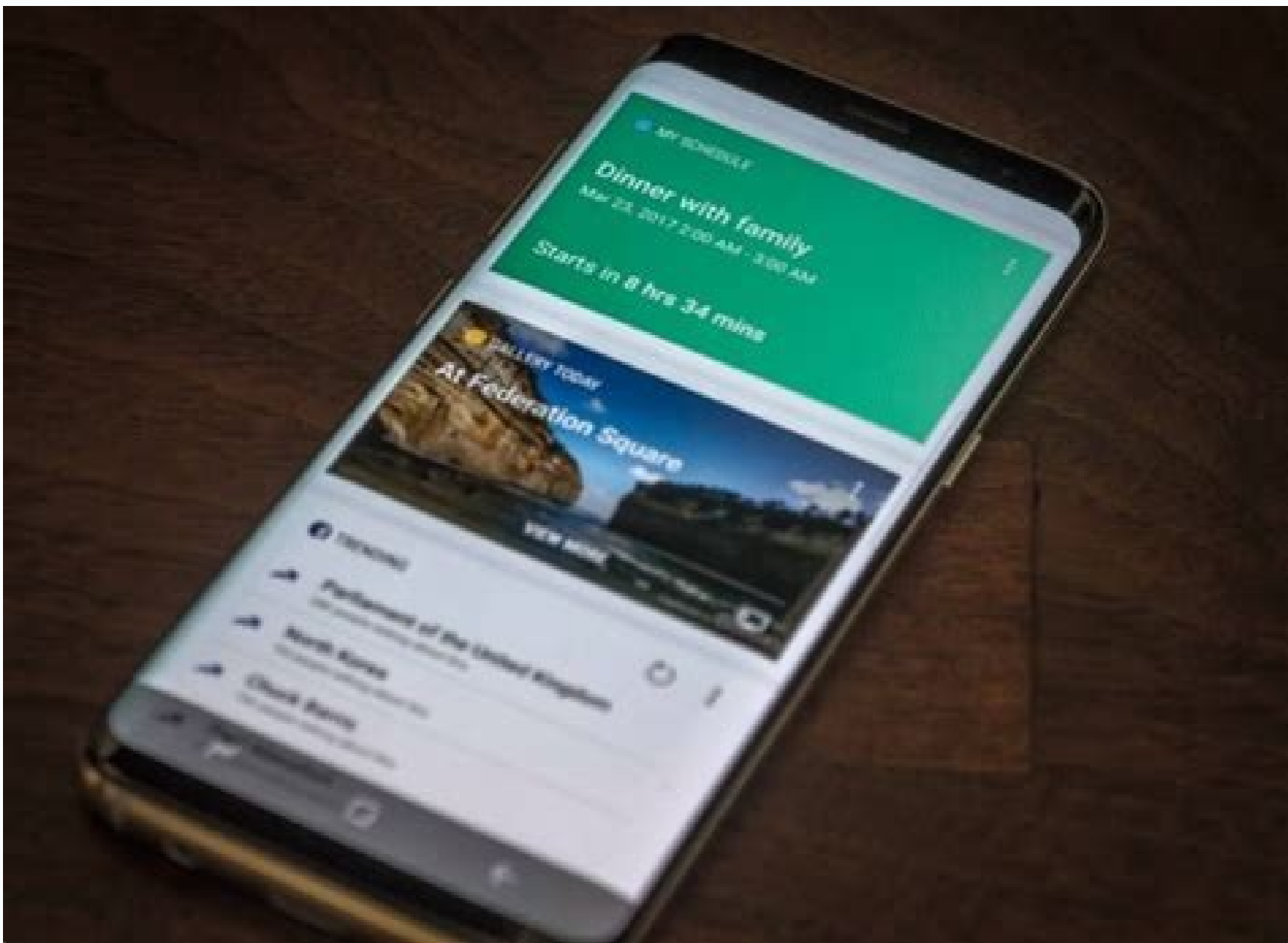
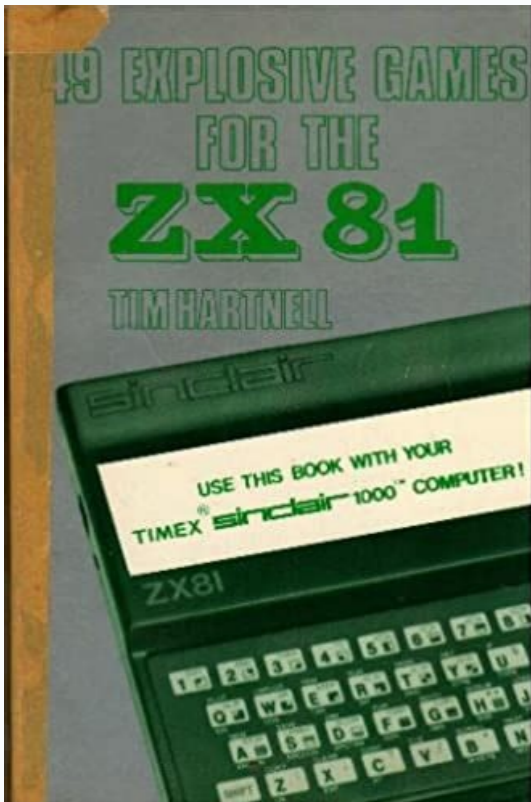

In the Queen's Gambit Declined we won't accept White's sacrifice and we just play a more neutral move like 2...e6. It is an opening you either love or hate and one of those chess openings that you cannot play casually, but it's an opening to be passionate about. Let's go over each of these extremely viable openings: Sicilian Dragon Sicilian Dragon. After you play 1...e5, it's going to be White who decides how the game continues, but most of the times it will be one of these 4 options: Italian Game.Scotch Game.Petroff Defense.Ruy Lopez (Spanish Opening). Black does not try to control the center early on with his pawns but spends some time fianchettoing his dark-squared bishop and only then attacks the center with his pieces. The purpose of the UA is to secure an advantage in Classical chess i.e. you always want to look for an advantage that you can prosecute using Classical chess principles. The move 1...Nf6 allows several solid and sharp defenses for Black against White's 1.d4. The Scotch Game begins with the moves 1.e4 e5 2.Nf3 Nc6 3.d4. Black is able to avoid early simplifications and can enter unbalanced positions, which allows him to play for more than equality. It's an extremely flexible move, and Black can choose to play many good proven openings that will guarantee you excellent possibilities of winning. The King's Indian Defense is one of the best chess openings for Black and was a favorite of the ultra-competitive chess World Champions Bobby Fischer and Garry Kasparov. GM Lemos recommends the Deferred Steinitz with 4...d6. The move 1...e6 after White's 1.e4 is called the Ruy Lopez. One of the greatest misconceptions in all of chess is that Knights are more active on c6 and f6 in the opening. Scotch Game Scotch Game. This is a good opening with which you can surprise your opponent. The Nimzo-Indian is similar to the Bogo-Indian except for the fact that Black plays ...Bb4 when the White knight is already placed on c3. The biggest difference in the UA is how you define time--In Classical chess time is defined as how many pieces you develop. To put it into a simple formula: Black first leaves the center to White and then tries to conquer it back due to his better development. In the Petroff, Black opts for a symmetrical structure that allows him to play in a positional fashion. Universal chess can be defined as having all your pieces in back of your pawns, never ahead (In universal chess there is either one open file or, at most two half open files; I define Universal mode is having all your pawns arranged so that your pawns are never overextended i.e. your opponent has no access to interior space with his/her pieces) of your pawns. The idea for Black is to delay the placement of his pawns in the center and instead develop the kingside rapidly. However, Black is fine here and has many moves at his disposal, such as 3...Bc5, 3...Nf6, 3...Be7 and 3...d6. The good thing about the French Defense is that it does not force you to learn an enormous amount of theory, because it's more important to know the key strategic ideas and plans in the middlegame. 1...Nf6. Black has three main options against White's setup, 3...dxe4 (the Rubinstein Variation), 3...Bb4 (the Winawer Variation), and 3...Nf6 (the Classical Variation). The Exchange Variation simplifies the game dramatically. The point of the UA is that it is not Classical chess, it is not Hypermodern chess. In Universal chess, time is defined as the acquisition of controlled space i.e. how many squares do you control behind your pawn wall. Italian Game Italian Game. After this, Black can fianchetto the bishop and put pressure on White's center or play the bishop to a6 and attack the c4 and e2 pawns. The Tarrasch Variation arises after the moves 1.e4 e6 2.d4 d5 3.Nd2. Here both players stayed in Universal mode almost the entire game. Here is the game Karpov-Ivanchuk. Here we go! Exchange Variation: 3.exd5 French Exchange. Black decides to fight for the center in a different way, putting pressure with one of the flank pawns instead of a central pawn. Check it out. If White chooses to go for this line, it's very likely they are okay with drawing the game. Ask yourself a question, "Does a Knight on f6 have greater likelihood of winding up on e4 or g4, than a Knight on e7 has to wind up on f5?" If the Black Knight winds up on f5, which is more active, a Knight on f6 or a Knight on f5? It's also one of the Sicilian

Defenses that has the least amount of theory. In the order of succession from least desirable to play against your opponent, then probably I would say against the Reti, then the Bird, then the English, then d-pawn openings and the toughest is against e-pawn players (Probably in the final choice, I'd stick with the Sicilian--- Obviously, the d-pawn player can transpose.) I like to call this opening the Anti-Reti or the Anti-English. It starts with the moves 1.e4 e6 2.d4 d5.

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
