The first lists included the poems of Emily Dickinson and the family quotes of Bartlett. Since 2006, Little, Brown and Company is a division of the Hachette Book group. [1] Little Little, Brown and Company has its roots in the field of book sales. It was founded in 1837 in Boston from Charles Little and James Brown. [1] [2] They set up the partnership "with the aim of publishing, importing and selling books". [1] Its roots date back to 1784 in a bookcase of Ebenezer's ownership boats in Marlborough Street. [1] They published works by Benjamin Franklin and George Washington and specialized in legal publishing and in the import of titles. [3] For many years it was the largest legal publisher of the United States, and also the largest importer of standard English law and various works, introducing American buyers to Encyclop[Ã]dia Brit[is]h, [3] to William Smith EA dictionaries Many other standard works. [4] In the early years Little and Brown published the works of Daniel Webster, the history of the United States of George Bancroft, Ferdinand and Isabella by William H. Prescott, the first book of poems by Jones Vory (edited by Ralph Waldo Emerson), letters by John Adams and works by James Russell Lowell and Francis Parkman. Little, Brown and Company was the US publisher of the book The DECLINE AND FLL OF THE ROMPIRE Empire by Edward Gibbon. [1] [3] The study was the original editor of the Statutes at Large of the United States starting from 1845, under the authority granted by a joint resolution of the congress. In 1874, the Congress transferred the authority to publish the Statutes in large to the government Printing Office, which has since been dealing with the production of the series. [6] In 1859, John Bartlett became a partner in the company. He held the rights on his family quotations and little, Brown published the fifteenth edition of his work in 1980, 125 years after his first publication. John Murray Brown, James Brown's son, took over when Augusto Bandg retired in 1884. In 1890, little, Brown expanded into general publishing, including fiction. In 1896, he published Quo Vadis. In 1898, small, Brown purchased a list of titles from Roberts Brothers Stud. [6] The 19th century employees included Charles Carroll Soule. [7] 20th century a little, brown and co. Little, Brown expanded to the UK in 1992, when TWBG acquired MacDonald & Co from Maxwell Communications, taking over its lists Abacus (luxury pamphlet) and Orbit (science fiction), and authors including Iain Banks. Feminist publisher Virago Press followed in 1996. Also in 1996, Wolters Kluwer acquired Little Brown's legal and medical publishing division and incorporated it into his Aspen and Lippincott-Raven prints.[10] 21st century In 2006, the Time Warner Book Group was sold to the French publishing house Hachette Livre. Later, the Little Brown imprint was used by Hachette Livre, Hachette Book Group USA. In 2011, Little, Brown launched a label dedicated to suspense publishing: Mulholland Books.[11] In February 2013, Reagan Arthur was chosen as the editor of Little, Brown, as she closed her five-year-old label, Reagan Arthur Books.[12] In October 2017, Little, Brown launched a new label dedicated to suspense publishing: Mulholland Books.
