The Bluetooth feature in your Nikon camera is more than just a gimmick. Using Nikon's SnapBridge app for the Android and iOS device, you can control your camera remotely as well as access pictures from the camera. That said, some Nikon users have reported Nikon camera not pairing with phone issue. This pairing problem is usually caused by a glitch in the SnapBridge app or problem with Nikon's Bluetooth functionality as reported in the Reddit community. NIKON D3400 not connecting to snapbridge. Please help. I have looked at and tried other posts and nothing has worked. Please read description, all suggestions massively appreciated. If you are also troubled by this issue, follow this guide to know how to fix the pairing issue with Nikon camera and phone. Guide to fix Nikon camera not pairing with the phone 1. Clear and cache and force close A bad cache can create issues while pairing your phone with the Nikon camera. Try clearing the cache and check if that resolves the issue. On your Android phone, tap on Settings from the Home Screen. Scroll down to Apps section. Tap on Manage apps. Wait for the installed apps list to load. Tap on the SnapBridge app to open it. Now, tap the Clear Cache button (bottom right). Choose Clear cache and then select Yes. Tap the Force Close button and choose Yes to confirm the action. This will force start the app. Now Turn on Bluetooth on your phone as well as Camera and try pairing. 5 best software for raw editing Nikon photos on Windows 10 2. Forget and re-pair At times a simple unpair and pair can fix Bluetooth connection issues. On your smartphone, tap on Settings. Open Bluetooth option. Make sure the Bluetooth is enabled. From the list of paired devices, tap on your Camera Name. Select Unpair to forget the device. Turn off Bluetooth on your Camera and your smartphone. Turn the Bluetooth back On, on both the device. Open the SnapBridge app and try pairing. 3. Uninstall and reinstall the app If the issue persists, try reinstalling the app. Uninstalling the app should clear any conflict with your phone. From your phone's home screen, tap and hold on the SnapBridge app icon. Select Uninstall and then tap on Yes to confirm. Restart the phone after uninstalling the app. Download the SnapBridge app from the PlayStore and install it. Now try pairing the device with your phone and see if that helps. The Camera Connect & Control is a third-party camera control app and a good alternative to SnapBridge. If the SnapBridge app is not working, try this app until the issue is resolved. Download Camera Connect & Control from the PlayStore. After installing the app, make sure to turn on the WiFi on your camera. Launch the app and proceed with connecting to your phone to Nikon camera. As mentioned earlier, the Nikon Camera Connect and Control app works over WiFi or USB connection. Conclusion That's it. I did a direct update to the newest firmware first. Then opened app and went through appearing. I also ran through updating the distortion control. One part was tricky. On the phone it took a minute before within the app, where it says choose an "accessory" i.e the camera name was not showing up instantly. I was able to pick eventually choose the camera name when it appeared with the app. I did turn on bluetooth and had deleted a previous pairing with a relative's android phone. Then it all worked. I had to accept both on the camera and the app. And it finished pairing. Btw, before I updated the firmware, I installed the app and tried to pair. TBH I'm not sure exactly what ended up doing the trick, but I repeatedly went into iPhone Settings:Bluetooth and deleted the camera from the pairings, then repeated the process, and eventually it took hold. I tried varying the wait times at each step and kicking off the pairing initiation from either the camera or the phone, and ultimately it worked. Probably went through it 10 times or so. Not exactly what I'm accustomed to with Apple, and I strongly suspect the disconnect is on the Nikon side, but they are finally connected and it seems to be sticking. Good luck! I have an iPhone 5S and have noticed that on many BT devices I have problems pairing them. The problem goes away once I get that first successful pairing but sometimes it can reappear after an IOS update. My car stereo took me almost 30 minutes to pair and it involved removing the old pairings and trying again several times until it finally accepted it. I really think that this is partly an Apple issue. I say that because older versions of IOS use to pair without problems, its only since IOS 8 that I have had this problem. I have even removed snapbridge app and reinstalled. I have updated the camera firmware to 1.11. I initially get the message saying I need to go to setting to select the camera WiFi. I have successfully done that. I go back into Snapbridge and select "Remote photography". I get the spinning icon and then the following error: Cannot connect to camera, possibly due to issues with the camera, smart device, or wireless signal strength. Try again after checking the camera and smart device. Tomorrow I'm going to have my friend try connecting to my camera with his phone. I'll also try connect my phone to his D500. Just trying to determine with device is having the issue.
