What to Bring RSM logo navy rucksack – See uniform list. Available from SWOTS. Two sizes available: smaller size recommended until Year 3. Art apron – Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 Wellies – Green Shoots, Kindergarten, Years 1 & 2 Old outdoor trainers – For use during playtime on the Bund from Y3 upwards. Waterproof trousers – Green Shoots, Kindergarten, Reception Playtime toy – Up to and including Year 2. Pocket-sized please, not expensive/precious/breakable/collectable. Snacks & water – Strictly no nuts or sesame (including peanut butter): we have severe allergies in school. – No chocolate or sweets allowed in school, please. – Please don't include items in need of refrigeration. – Snacks should be sent in small container/s rather than lunch boxes as they need to fit into the child's tray.
