To play this withdrawal model, you will use your thumb (P), index (I) and average (m) fingers on the collecting hand. (Hanging hand) See the first example of the tab below. While playing an Open C agreement, he teared the strings using the thumb and fingers as indicated by the P. Note that the first notes in each bar are torn together by P & M while the next 6 notes are popped individually. Work on this slowly. Note the time and pace I used in this example and do your best to copy it. Click the diagrams for an MP3 audio example. Play this model on an Open rope. For example, a major triad consists of the notes C, B and D (the root, the third and the fifth, respectively). It is possible to alternate between the root and theExample 1a), the root and third (example 1b) or a combination of all three notes (example 1c). Getting a firm and solid feeling is essential, so make sure you are comfortable with these examples before switching to a later examples. Although these examples only show the possibilities of a G chord, be sure to familiarize yourself with the bass notes for other forms of chords. You can also explore the different sounds you got when palm-muting the bass notes, lightly resting the outer edge of your picking hand on the strings next to the guitar deck. Advertisement After you can keep a constant rhythm of the bass, it is time to add notes on the strings of treble, chosen with the index (i) and middle (m) fingers. The series in Examples 2ac provides a methodological way of doing this, with the addition of quarterly notes, eighth note, and the e of eighth notes. Hold a G chord held with your fingers fretting throughout, and let all notes play for as long as possible. Examples 3a-c have the same treble string pattern as the previous set, but notice the change in the alternating bass-note pattern. Adjusting to this little detail might be harder than you think, so take your time to do it under your fingers and into your muscle memory. A more synchronized approach to treble strings is seen in Example 4a, one of the most common Travis-picking patterns. Try this model with a C chord, as in Example 4b, and you might recognize suggestions from KansasDust in the Wind or Fleetwood Mac Landslide. If you are in the early stages of ditapicking, proceed slowly, to make sure you are nailing the correct movement mechanics while playing with rhythmic precision. Inches, Non Strums Once you have developed a familiarity with the basics of the pattern, start integrating it into your repertoire. Try to make a qualitative leap with a song that usually strum, and see how it changes the feel of the song. Example 5 is a simple progression ii-VI (DmGC) in C, and demonstrates how to apply the model to a succession of chords having different roots on the fourth, fifth, and sixth strings. You can apply these ideas to any progression agreement-and remember, there is only one "right" way to play the pattern. Making some chords A great way to start developing your arrangements is to practice with simple melodies. Take, for example, the by "Skip to My Lou". Start by isolating the melody, to make sure you know it well (Example 8.) Also get acquainted with the corresponding progression of the agreements. Example 9 shows only one possible way to integratein a collection model. When you try this idea for yourself, start with an easy melody in a key that is manageable. With any luck, after working through these exercises, you will have been new tools to start developing your creative perspectives on collecting Travis. Which means what, exactly? Let's start with a G chord and see. The first step is to establish the bass notes. Bass notes are the notes played with the thumb, usually on the sixth, fifth and fourth strings. On a G chord, the bass notes are on the sixth string and the fourth string, as in Example 1.1.Travising The pickup is always in 4/4, which means there are four beats in each bar, and every quarter note counts for one beat. That, at least, is how theorists describe it. By the way, that description always left me stranded when I was at school, to say that Travis's withdrawal is in 4/4 means only this: you can touch your foot and, if you do, you can count those foot taps in groups of four.Vvertisement Each group of four beats is called a measurement (or a  - bar Terms are used interchangeably). So now we can talk about the first, the second, the third, or the fourth beat in a measure. So, to play a measure of the bottom of a Travis pickup pattern on a G chord, we play the sixth string on beat 1, the fourth string on beat 2, the sixth string on beat 3, and the fourth string on beat 4.
